Day 1

To use addition and subtraction in the context of money

In this lesson you will be using addition and subtraction skills and finding out how much change you will get from a certain amount of money.



Support

Ask what each coin is called. If possible use real coins.

Play shops (using 1p-2p-5p coins) but this time you will be adding coins to make amounts. Keep amounts below 10p. For example, If I buy a car for 2p and a teddy for 3p. How much money will I need?



How much is in the Piggy? Put some coins into a container and ask your child to add them together to tell you the total. Keep amounts below 10p and increase slowly!

Alesha bought a monster using only silver coins. It cost her 45p.



There are nine different ways to pay 45p exactly using only silver coins.

Find as many as you can.

What if the monster cost 50p?

How many different ways are there to pay now?
