


## Geography week 5: Suggested for Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2021.

### Task 1: Research key questions.

2. What is the climate like?
3. What animals do they have there?
4. How many countries make up the continent? Can you list 5?
5. How many people live there?
6. Find out about one tourist attraction.

**Task 2:** Imagine you were planning a holiday to this continent. What would you pack? Draw and label at least **5 items** inside your suitcase. **Challenge:** Explain why you would take those items.




**Other tasks:** Choose at least one (you can do more or all of them if you would like to)
