Foundation Learning- This week's focus- People who help us

This week's foundation learning will begin with looking at how germs are spread and measures that can be taken to prevent this. You will learn the importance of effective hand washing and other measures that prevent the transfer of germs. You will then listen to a story about real life superheroes (doctors) and then think about some more of the very special people in our communities who help us. At the end of the lesson, you will think about what your dream job is. Next you will be thinking of actions to accompany the colours of the rainbow, and try to put them all together in a fun song and dance along at the end! You will then learn about the different places that people who help us work in and be asked to use construction resources to build a representation of a building where people who help us work. Finally, you will learn all about how a rainbow is made and have a go at making one yourself. You can choose to draw or paint a picture of your rainbow afterwards. The three key areas that these lesson links to are Expressive Arts and Design, Physical Development, and Communication and Language.

Maths- Grouping and Sharing

This week's foundation learning will begin with a story and recap finding one less than a given number. After that, you will be shown how to share equally between two groups. You can practise sharing equally between two at home - for example, you could share out your counting objects, divide cards to play snap or share a set of dominoes between two people. You could share a healthy snack like Zara or have a go at sharing your toys between two people in your home. Next you will learn about what a pair is. You will decide how many pairs of socks different animals need, counting the socks individually and in pairs. You will then learn how to count in twos. Finally, you will investigate what can be shared into equal groups and what happens if things cannot be shared equally.
