
Challenge: Write a letter to your friend or special teddy telling them what makes you worried and what you do to help you when you are worried.

Challenge: Write your own set of instructions on how to make a rainforest for someone else to follow.


Maths – Addition and Subtraction

Monday – Exploring addition by adding on
