Today we will learn what makes us unique. We will learn that we are all different and that there are special things that make us who we are. We will listen to story about a boy who is from a different country so doesn't speak English. We will then think about what makes us unique by looking at our appearance, our community and the things we enjoy doing. You will be asked to tell your teddy or a grown up what makes you unique. Get a grown up to record what makes you unique and add it to Tapestry. Or you could draw and write makes you unique and upload it to Tapestry.

Finding it tricky? Go back to yesterday's lesson and become confident with the names of the 3D shapes.

Need a challenge? Can you choose a 3D shape, draw a picture of it and write one fact about the shape you have chosen. How many faces does it have? Does it have any vertices?

Or a child may hear some of the sounds in the word but not all, this is perfectly acceptable and they should only write what they hear.
