Below are the topic tasks that we have set for the week. We hope that you enjoy them!

### **Task 1**

Open the PowerPoint, 'Toys from the Past' and watch the videos within. Talk about these toys with an adult - a parent is great, but a grandparent is even better! Discuss the differences between the toys which they played with when they were younger and the toys which you play with now.

Think about:

- What are the toys made of?
- How are they made?
- How do they work? What are they powered by?

### **Task 2**

Now that you know a bit about toys from the past, can you draw one? Label it (using a ruler to draw the lines) to show what the toy is made from, how it is made, what powers it or any other key parts/information.

### **Task 3**

Could you draw a second picture of a modern toy? Label it with the same things to show the differences between old and new.

### **Challenge**

DEEPER THINKING - Why are most toys today made of plastic instead of wood or metal?

Parents - lead the conversation by talking about safety, cost, ease of manufacture, etc.
