KIT LIST!

“There’s no such thing as bad weather, just bad clothing”. We’ve heard this comment for years, but it’s certainly true and some preparation will make your child’s stay much more comfortable.

Below is a suggested list of clothing and other items that your child will find useful during their visit.

- Sleeping bag, pillow and pillow slip for all accommodation types
- Sleeping mat if you’re staying in tents
- Plenty of comfortable clothing that can get dirty
- T-shirts
- Several sweatshirts/pullovers (lots of thin layers)
- Shorts and jeans or tracksuit bottoms
- Spare underclothes & socks
- Waterproof clothing, coat and trousers
- Smart casual clothes may be useful for the evenings

-Please, please, please - make sure you send plenty of clothing that you will not mind becoming dishevelled/not making it home. Could be one or two changes on some of the days. Lightweight, quick-drying clothing. Not heavy cotton or jeans!!!

- More than one pair of trainers & a pair of wellies THAT YOU KNOW FIT!
- Please name on each clothes label your child’s name. Use felt-tip pen.
- Bring two plastic bags for your wet and dirty clothes.
- Bring a pair of gloves and warm hat for early mornings & late evenings.
- There is a disco on Thursday evening so a ‘special outfit’ may be required...
- NO portable, electrical items. Cameras can be brought at own risk. And a torch for evening activities.

ACCOMMODATION

- ◉ Whole of Year 6 in the same building - Ben's House.
- ◉ 24 hour warden on-site.
- ◉ Children sleeping four to a room. One adult supervising three rooms.
- ◉ We will endeavour to have children in rooms with their friends.
- ◉ Cocoa and biscuits before bedtime.
- ◉ Teddies are welcome! But, they must fit in your bag...No responsibility for loss or damage!
- ◉ A gated, manned, secure site.
- ◉ Controlled entrance.
- ◉ Windows left ajar as they are child-safe. Doors to Ben's House on a key code that the children will know.
- ◉ Majority of activities outdoors.

ON THE DAY OF DEPARTURE

Normal drop-off at school in North playground on Monday. Children place their bag in the Unity Building upon entry at 8:30am.

On Friday, usual pick-up time from the North playground.

IMPORTANT EXTRAS!

Your child is allowed to bring up to £5 in change, in a named purse as 'Gift money' for the week. Your child will be responsible for looking after it and keeping the money in a safe place.
